### Aims & Target Group

**Aims:** Kar Kulture will encourage contact between young people from migrant communities and from the broader community in Dandenong. This project will help to break down barriers between the different culture groups and promote harmony.

**Target Group:** CALD and non-CALD youth from Dandenong area.

### Project Description & Components

The 'Kar Kulture' program where 10 CALD youth team up with 10 non-CALD youth to restore cars. Vehicles were later used to train for obtaining drivers licences

Key activities involve:

- A diverse group of young people working together to restore a car and participate in driver education activities.
- Participants were involved in project planning and investigation of funding and sponsorship options to support sustainability of the project.

### Process

Driver safety workshops were run for participants and opportunity given to obtain their learner permits. After the completion of the vehicle, volunteers were recruited to provide driving practice time to the participants of the project.
